Helena W. Rodbard, MD is Past-President of the American College of Endocrinology (ACE), and Past-President of the American Association of Clinical Endocrinologists (AACE). She recently served as Chairperson of the Clinical Practice Guidelines Task Force that developed the most recent AACE Medical Guidelines for Clinical Practice for the Management of Diabetes Mellitus. She has been involved in the development of several other clinical practice guidelines, including the treatment of dyslipidemias. As President of ACE she also convened an international consensus conference developing recommendations for the screening and treatment of type 2 diabetes mellitus.

Dr. Rodbard is a Master of the American College of Endocrinology and a Fellow of the American College of Physicians. She completed fellowships at the National Institute of Child Health and Human Development (NICHD) and in the Diabetes Branch of the National Institute for Diabetes, Digestive and Kidney Diseases (NIDDK), NIH. She has conducted research involving both basic and clinical aspects of diabetes and other endocrine disorders and currently leads an active program of clinical investigation.

Dr. Rodbard has served on the faculties of Georgetown University Medical School and George Washington University Medical Center. She has served as a member of the Board of the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation. Dr. Rodbard has lectured extensively regarding diabetes and other endocrine disorders, both nationally and internationally.

Dr. Rodbard is engaged in a very active, well established and highly respected private practice of endocrinology with a focus on diabetes and metabolic disorders. She has been consistently listed in *Best Doctors in America* and *Best Doctors in Washington, DC*.
